The One-Liner

Complex yet approachable old vine, low yielding Bobal from Eastern Spain

Tasting Note

Aromas of forest fruit aromas together with notes of toffee and vanilla. The palate is complex and structured, with more blackberry and plum characters, smooth tannins, a touch of mocha and a long finish.

Producer Details

Bodegas Murviedro was founded in 1927 as the Spanish subsidiary of the Swiss Schenk Group and has grown to become one of the most important wineries in the region

The company's philosophy is based on combining the modern winemaking techniques with grapes from traditional vineyards - to meet the highest international quality standards, while maintaining their Spanish character and originality.

In The Vineyard

Made exclusively from low-yielding, old vine Bobal fruit grown in the area known as 'Medio Dia' - where the soil is chalk/clay with little organic content. This, together with long hours of sunshine, and large variations between day and night temperatures, result in very low, yet high quality, yields.

In The Winery

The grapes are destemmed and gently pressed followed by a long maceration at controlled temperature. Malolactic fermentation takes place, and then the wine is aged in new American and French 'Allier' barrels for eight months.

Food Recommendations

Drink with roast lamb or beef dishes
