## Tasting Note

Château Villotte belongs to Denis Baro, the wily yet very fair president of the Cave de Rauzan growers. This is a classic and traditional example; restrained aromas with a pithy, zesty palate - an excellent food accompaniment.

## Producer Details

Château Villotte belongs to Denis Baro, the wily yet very fair president of the Cave de Rauzan growers. Château Villotte is on the site of a medieval property, the current château built in the renaissance. Vines here come under AOP Bordeaux and Entre-Deux-Mers and consist of classic Bordeaux varieties Cabernets Sauvignon and Franc, Merlot, Sauvignon Blanc, Sémillon and Muscadelle.

## In The Winery

One third of the grapes receive an extended cold maceration to extract aroma. Thermo-regulated fermentation in stainless steel at 18-20 degrees.

## Notes

Bordeaux dry whites are one of the region's best-kept secrets. They have not always been worth rediscovering but over the past few generations, growing techniques have improved and the 2014 is a very good vintage for whites.
