The Estate

Hawksdrift is a family owned and operated vineyard, located in the Dillons Point region of Marlborough, New Zealand. Murray and Robyn Butt were among the first to pioneer growing grapes in this area. Shelter from the Wither Hills range, contributes to a long, hot ripening season, meaning, the fruit is left to ripen when other, cooler areas have shut down.

This long hang time develops fully ripened summer flavours in the fruit.

Winemaking

Hand-picked fruit from a single Marlborough vineyard. Fully barrel-fermented, the wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels. Our grapes are grown from 20 year old vines. Our wine is hand-crafted, and we always aim to create small batches of high quality wine.

Tasting Note and Food Pairing

This is a fulsome Chardonnay with complex stonefruit, nutty and flinty flavours. Savoury yellow stonefruits and citrus fruits entwined with strong nutty elements. Match with seafood, poultry and pork dishes.
