Declassified Prosecco with 5% Brachetto juice added to give a delicate pink fizz with light berry fruit flavours.

Tasting Note

A delicate pink sparkling rosé with strawberry and raspberry aromas and soft berry characters on the palate. Fresh acidity balanced by zesty, cherry notes makes this an easy and appealing fizz.

Producer Details

Established in 2003, **Adria Vini** is a winemaking venture jointly owned by **Boutinot** and **Araldica Castelvero**, the leading co-operative in the Monferrato hills of Piemonte. Our aim is to produce authentic, well-priced still and sparkling wines from local grape varieties.

All aspects of production, from grape selection through to vinification, maturation, blending and bottling are meticulously overseen by Araldica's winemaking team of Claudio Manera and Lella Burdese - assisted by Boutinot's Tony Brown MW.

We source from a range of private growers and cooperatives, with whom we have long term relationships, principally in *Veneto, Friuli, Lombardy, Sicily, Puglia, Abruzzo* and *Sardinia*.

In The Vineyard

From selected parcels of Glera grapes grown north-east of Treviso. Hand harvested at optimum ripeness.

In The Winery

Gentle pneumatic pressing - with 5% Brachetto juice added. Followed by slow, cool fermentation in stainless steel. Second fermentation in tank, lasting 4 weeks.

Food Recommendations

Perfect aperitif and picnic wine.
