



WINE DESCRIPTION	Montgras Aura Estate Merlot 2018 6/75cl

WINERY BACKGROUND	If wineries were sprinters, then MontGras would be Usain Bolt. Set up 25 years ago by two brothers Hernán & Eduardo Gras, along with partner Cristián Hartwig, they got out of the starting blocks with lightning speed, and were crowned IWSC Chilean Winery of the Year with just 10 years under their belt. They mean business and they make great wines from their estates in Leyda, Maipo and Colchagua.
WINEMAKING NOTES	
VINEYARDS	Vineyards are located in the central valley of Chile, where you can find different types of soil, most of them being loamy, aluvial and coluvial over 3 metres deep. Climate has a high continentality, presenting important differences in between day and night temperatures, with four well marked seasons. Trellising methods vary from vertical shoot, Lyre and GDC.
VINIFICATION	The grapes were destemmed and inoculated with selected yeast for fermenting between 28 - 30 C / 82 - 86 F. Only 10% had oak contact during 5 months, looking for preserving the fruity characters of the variety.

TASTING NOTES	Full of fruity aromas such as ripe cherry, blackberries and currant. With a medium body, it is round wine with ripe tannins that complements nicely with its red fruit flavours.

FOOD MATCH	Great with fatty fish like salmon or sea bass. It also goes well with pork or sweet breads.
